As a Houseparent, you will supervise and meet the daily needs of up to 8 children in your care, provide a stable and safe environment, and model a healthy family relationship.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES/ACTIVITIES

Supervise children in the daily activities of cottage (home) life. Pick up groceries and stock the cottage pantry with adequate food and supplies. Prepare or supervise preparation of cottage meals. Transport children in a Mission vehicle to school, doctor appointments, activities, and events. Inventory, track and distribute medication to a child as needed. Teach basic household chores/responsibilities to the residents. Maintains the home inside and outside in a clean and safe condition. Provide homework help/monitoring. Be a Christ like role model and attend Church service every Sunday at Eben Ezer Lutheran Church. Communicate with guardians. Collaborate between medical/school services, guardians, social worker, case worker, child and other houseparents. Other assigned duties.
